Uniform Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Designated grade-level shirt purchased from the school • Tucked in at all times 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non-school uniform shirts • Holes or markings on shirts • untucked
Pants/shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shorts must be to the knee or longer • Pants must be loose around ankle • <u>Uniform style</u> in black, navy blue or khaki • Must fit loosely throughout leg • Must have belt loops 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Above the knee shorts • Cargo pants • Skinny pants • Black jeans, Khaki jeans, Navy blue jeans • Joggers (tight elastic around the ankle) • Skirts/skorts not allowed
Footwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athletic gym shoes for running • Clean with foot fully covered • Socks must be neutral colors and not reach calf muscle 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flats, Heels, Cleats, Sandals, Boots • No bright colored socks • No socks that reach or pass the calf muscle
Belts (<i>Mandatory for grades 3-8th everyday</i>)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid black, brown or navy blue belt only. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prints, Studs, Bright colors
Outer Wear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid black, navy blue, red, grey or white only • Cardigan style opened in front with zipper or buttons • Long sleeve shirts may be worn under uniform shirt– must be solid black, navy blue, red, grey or white only. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No hats, caps, bandannas, or other headwear are allowed. • No outerwear, such as windbreakers, jean jackets, or ski jackets, may be worn inside the classroom. Such items must be stored in the student’s locker. • “Hoodies” may not be worn inside the school building. • No pullovers or sweatshirts are allowed. • No patterns or multi colored prints on sweaters or long sleeve shirts
Personal Appearance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clean face and combed hair • Neatly ironed and stainless clothes • Girls may wear tasteful make-up and nail polish that does not call attention to the student. • Girls may wear simple stud earrings. No large hoops and hanging earrings. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No extreme hairstyles (Mohawk/Fohawk/ Designs Cut and Spiked-Up) or extreme colored hair are allowed. Boys’ hair may not pass the neck. • No tattoos or body piercings (permanent or temporary) are allowed. • Boys may not wear earrings • No spiked or gauged earrings
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uniforms with torn pants or shirts with holes are not allowed.
